#### **15. Good Morning Earth by Heidi Ann Wilson, inspired by Haudenasauni Thanksgiving Address**

Heidi Wilson says: “This song is inspired by (and also quite different from the) Haudenosaunee Thanksgiving Address shared by Mohawk Elder Jake Swamp, founder of the Tree of Peace Society. Jake Swamp invited people in the Wilderness School community to make their own practice of Thanksgiving, and this song is one of the ways I like to do it.

The Thanksgiving Address (Ohén:ton Karihwatéhkwen - Words Before All Else) come from the Haudenosaunee (also Iroquois or Six Nations — Mohawk, Oneida, Cayuga, Onondaga, Seneca, and Tuscarora). ‘The address is based on the belief that the world cannot be taken for granted, that a spiritual communication and thankfulness and acknowledgement of all living things must be given to align the minds and hearts of people with Nature... Today these words are still spoken at the opening and closing of all ceremonial and governmental gatherings held by the Six Nations.’ - Thanksgiving Address: Greetings to the Natural World. A booklet produced by the Native Self Sufficiency Center, Six Nations Indian Museum [www.sixnationsindianmuseum.com](http://www.sixnationsindianmuseum.com), Tracking Project, and Tree of Peace.”
